REPORT OF RESTORATION TEAM
COMPLETION OF RESTORATION COVENANT WITH
Rev. John E. (Pete) Tackett

Pete committed any sin that would disqualify him from serving in the ministry permanently.

With this in mind and knowing that only God has the ability to judge and restore, we can without hesitation state that as best we know how to facilitate these divine actions, we are glad to confirm that Bro. Pete has been restored by our Heavenly Father and is ready to resume ministerial duties as the Lord leads.
